### BIOGRAPHY

Travis P. Clardy attended Abilene Christian University where he received his B.B.A. in Management, in 1984. He graduated from Pepperdine University School of Law in 1988 and was a member of the Pepperdine Law Review from 1986-1988.

Mr. Clardy is the former president of the Shelby and Nacogdoches County Bar Associations and a member of the American Board of Trial Advocates (East Texas Chapter) and State Bar of Texas. In addition to Clardy's legal affiliations, he has served on the Executive Board of the East Texas Boy Scouts, is a Paul Harris Fellow at the Nacogdoches Rotary Club, and a member of the Dean's Circle for the Stephen F. Austin State University College of Fine Arts.

Mr. Clardy is the current State representative for House District 11, representing Cherokee, Nacogdoches, and Rusk counties. He was appointed to serve on two House committees for the 86th Legislative Session: the Committee on Homeland Security and Public Safety, and the Committee on Human Services. For his legislative endeavors, Rep. Clardy was recognized as a Legislator of the Year by the Texas Municipal Police Association, earned the Courageous Conservative Award by the Texas Conservative Coalition, and was declared A+ rated by the Texas Future Business Alliance. He was ranked as one of the top five most influential freshman members by Capitol Inside's Texas Legislative Power Rankings and received a 100% score for his voting record by the Texas Association of Business.
